

Warden's Report

2022

This has been an exciting year for our church. We removed the wall between the Nave and Hall, almost doubling our worship space. We were able to change the flooring in the nave from carpet to vinyl so that it could more easily be used as coffee hour space. Many thanks to Greg Miller at Artistix Texas. We were also blessed with a much larger refrigerator donated by Christina Drowden's mother. A new drain pump for the baptismal font and the cabinet for the book store were also donated.

We also acquired several new Icons. The large Icon behind the altar was commissioned to be painted for us and was paid for by donations from our parishioners. Several other Icons were also purchased and the Icon of Christ at the front door was donated anonymously.

We also installed a sound system this year so that both Father and Choir could be heard more easily in the back half of the church.

Ultimately we agreed to make this space function as efficiently as possible while looking for a larger building to lease or buy. We were also able to get the book store up and running.
